

Litany of Confirmation, Profession of Faith, and Full Membership

"He saved us, not because of any works of righteousness that we had done, but because of his mercy.

He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit." -- Titus 3:5

"That if you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord', and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved...for 'Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.'
--Romans 10:10, 13

Leader: People of God, through the Sacrament of Baptism we are initiated into the Body of Christ, the church; Moreover, in baptism we are embraced into God's salvation through Jesus Christ, and given new birth through water and the Spirit. All this is God's gift, offered to us without price. Through confirmation and the reaffirmation of faith, we confirm and renew acceptance of God's gift of salvation and confirm our commitment to the church.

(Introduce the Candidates for baptism and confirmation)

Leader (to confirmands): Do you confess Jesus Christ as your Savior, put your whole trust in his grace, and promise to serve him as your Lord?

Confirmands: I do

Leader: With God's help, will you remain faithful members of Christ's holy church and serve as

Christ's representatives in the world?

Confirmands: | will

Leader (to the congregation): Do you, as Christ's body, the church, reaffirm both your rejection of sin, your commitment to Christ, and your commitment to nurture these young people in their Christian walk?

Congregation: We do. With God's help we will live according to the example of Christ and surround these young people with a community of love and forgiveness, that they may grow in their trust of God and service to others. We will pray for them, that they may grow as true disciples who walk in the way that leads to life.

Leader: Do you, in the presence of God and this congregation renew the solemn vow and promise made at your baptism?

Confirmands: I do

Leader: Do you truly and earnestly repent of your sin?

Confirmands: I do.

Leader: Do you believe in God the Father?

Confirmands: I believe in God, the Father Almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

Leader: Do you believe in Jesus Christ?

Confirmands: I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, is seated at the right hand of the Father, and will come again to judge the living and the dead.

Leader: Do you believe in the Holy Spirit?

Confirmands: I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic* church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. *Worldwide Body of Christ

Leader: Do you receive and profess the Christian faith as contained in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments? Do you promise, according to the grace given you to keep God's holy will and as faithful members of Christ's holy church?

Confirmands: I do.

Leader: We bless this water of baptism. Our Father, pour out your Holy Spirit on this gift of water, as a reminder of the washing away of sin, the refreshment of your forgiving love, and the cleansing of our souls in the gift of everlasting life through Jesus, your Son, our Savior

BAPTISM OF THE CONFIRMANDS REQUIRING BAPTISM

Congregational Response: Through Baptism you are incorporated by the Holy Spirit into God's new creation and made to share in Christ's royal priesthood. We are all one in Christ Jesus. With joy and thanksgiving we welcome you as members of the family of Christ.

REAFFIRMATION OF FAITH AND BAPTISM FOR CONFIRMANDS

Leader (to all Confirmands): As members of the Body of Christ, will you be loyal to the church and as members of Carrollton First, faithfully participate in its ministries by your prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness?

Leader (to the Congregation): Members of the family of God, I commend these young people to your love and care. Do all in your power to increase their faith, confirm their hope, and perfect them in love.

Congregation: We give thanks for all that God has already given you, our young people, and we welcome you in Christian love. As members together with you in the Body of Christ and in this congregation, we renew our covenant faithfully to participate in the ministries of Carrollton First by our prayers, our presence, our gifts, our service, and our witness, that in everything God may be glorified in Jesus Christ.
