December 10, 2023 ● 11 a.m. ● Second Sunday in Advent

On this second week of Advent, we prepare our hearts with expectation and anticipation of the coming of our King of Peace, The One who came to liberate us, and who will come again in Glory as He has promised. It had been nearly 700 years following the Prophet Isaiah, before the fulfillment of all that Isaiah had prophesied, to include what we learn of in today's Gospel reading of Mark 1:1-13, where Isaiah even foretold of John the Baptist, who would come before Jesus, preaching a baptism of repentance for the remission of sins, while pointing to the Mighty One after him, who would baptize with the Holy Spirit. The beauty and depth of the Bible is amazing—-its Christology, typology, and prophesy foretelling over 350 specific prophesies by over 40 men across it's 1,500 years of written composition into 66 books comprising our Old and New Testaments, all of which have been fulfilled by our Glorious Lord and King and Redeemer, including what we learn of today in Mark's Gospel . It is truly His-story, which He enables and calls us to participate within. Why did He do it? The King of Peace came with you and me in mind, to liberate us, even from our very selves, so we may enjoy Him and one another in beauty, truth, and love forever. Emmanuel-He is with us!


