We are so thrilled to announce the following exciting news for our congregation. Our Staff Parish Relations Committee, along with our steering committee, has vetted some exceptional consultant Church organizations and has unanimously agreed to retain the services of Center for Healthy Churches. Their representative Joel Snider will begin in an interim pastoral role starting January 7, as we proceed along our faithful

discernment path forward. CHC's information may be reviewed at this link - https://chchurches.org/ CHC has placed over 200 pastors across multiple denominations with a 97.5% success rate to date. We will be following defined established processes which will involve full engagement with our entire congregation for pastoral profile development along with vision and mission casting. This process may take 6 months to a year to complete. Additionally, I am thrilled to announce Alison Tanner has agreed to an interim worship planning role, and will work with Joel in his interim pastoral role to ensure we have well established worship order and planning during this transition period. Joy Griffin has graciously agreed to assist Alison as needed. Please join me in welcoming Joel Snider and Alison Tanner in their new interim roles, and in thanking Joy for the exceptional worship planning she has led for the past several weeks since our disaffiliation, and her continued assistance in doing so. If this weren't enough exciting news for one announcement, I am thrilled to also add Nelson Amaya, who has agreed and been approved by our Staff Parish Relations Committee to lead our Hispanic Ministry, beginning January 1. To God be the glory as we seek to be His faithful church, where all are welcome and encouraged to join us in worship. God's vision for our future is spectacular.
