## Called Charge Conference, Today, February 19 12:15

At the recommendation of the Finance Committee, the Staff Parish Relations Committee (SPRC) and the Administrative Council, our district superintendent, Rev. Jessica Terrell has authorized our church to hold a Charge Conference for the singular purpose of receiving a recommendation from the SPRC. Because of current giving, the church has reluctantly continued the salaries of all staff at 2022 levels and not implemented a 4.5% cost of living raise for staff. However, the senior pastor's salary in 2023 budget can only be adjusted by action of a Charge Conference. Members of the Administrative Council and clergy who are part of our church have voice and vote. **The meeting will be held in room 206 at 12:15 on Sunday, February 19, 2023.** This meeting should be brief since this particular salary is all that will be discussed and decided.
