



The Sacrament of Baptism

"Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these." --Matthew 19:14

Leader: Brothers and sisters in Christ, through the sacrament of baptism we are initiated into the Body of Christ, the church. Infant baptism or christening shows forth the gift of salvation as God's work, offered to us without price--and long before our capacity to choose.

(To parents) Do you confess Jesus Christ as your Savior, put your whole trust in his grace, and promise to serve him as your Lord?

Parents: I do.

Leader: Will you nurture Charlie in the church, that by your teaching and example he may be guided to accept God's grace for himself, profess his faith openly, and to lead a Christian life?

Parents: I do.

Leader (to congregation): Do you as Christ's body, the church, reaffirm both your rejection of sin and your commitment to Christ?

Congregation: We do.

Leader: Will you nurture one another in the Christian faith and life and include this child now before you in your care?

Congregation: With God's help, we will proclaim the Good News and live according to the example of Christ. We will surround this child with a community of love, forgiveness, and Biblical teaching, that he may grow as a disciple of Jesus Christ. We will pray for him, that he may be a true disciple who walks in the way that leads to life

Leader: We bless this water of baptism. Our Father, pour out your Holy Spirit on this gift of water, as a reminder of the washing away of sin, the refreshment of your forgiving love, and the cleansing of our souls in the gift of everlasting life through Jesus, your Son, our Savior.

All: Sing the first verse of "Jesus Loves Me" (two times)

(Welcome and Dedication at the Altar)

Leader: Charlie we welcome you to the Family of God. And all the people of God said...

Congregation: Amen
